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Minutes of the of Swine Parish Council Meeting held on 9th February 2021
Remotely via Zoom

02/2021/01 - Attendance: Cllrs Y Wilkinson, E McMullen, D Oliver, G Bloom, A Thompson, J Mackereth and A Hunter.

02/2021/02 - Apologies: None

02/2021/03 - Approval of minutes: Minutes of the meeting held on 1st December 2020 were read and approved. These will be signed by the Chair as approved at a future date.

02/2021/04 - Police Crime Report: Crime reports received since the last meeting had been circulated to Councillors on email or hard copy prior to the meeting.

02/2021/05 - Clerk's Report:

- (A) Clerk confirmed that correspondence had been sent to East Riding of Yorkshire Council regarding the grass cutting schedule, repair to the style/footpath marker and bricks from the bridge repair. An email response had been received from Paul Palmer confirming that between March and October areas shown on the attached map are cut on a 15 working day cycle. Councillors questioned whether Main Street was covered by a separate cut schedule. Clerk to raise with East Riding of Yorkshire Council. No response has been received to the other two matters raised.
- (B) Clerk confirmed that correspondence had been sent to Everinghams, SP Memorials and Timeless Memorials regarding the lettering on the war memorial in January. No responses received so far, but Clerk will chase up.
- (C) The salt ins appear to have been checked on 27th January. Workers from East Riding of Yorkshire Council were seen at the bin at the top of Main Street and when the Clerk checked there appeared to have been fresh salt added.
- (D) Clerk confirmed that the updated Register of Electors had been received.

02/2021/06 - Finance:

- (A) BHIB had been asked for quotes to compare with the renewal price given by Zurich Insurance. BHIB had not been able to obtain a quotation to come within £100 of the Zurich renewal price so Clerk recommended renewing as soon as possible to maintain cover. Councillors agreed and a cheque will be drawn for the amount of £224 (to be

signed as soon as possible following the meeting). (Local Government Act 1972, ss 140(1) and 111))

- (B) Clerk confirmed that the Parish Council's precept demand had been submitted and confirmation of approval received. The precept should be in the Parish Council's bank account in early April

02/2021/07 – East Riding of Yorkshire Council's consultation on the Draft Flood Risk

Sequential and Exception Test Supplementary Planning Document: This lengthy document had been circulated to Councillors prior to the meeting for consideration and it was agreed by all that the Parish Council had no comments they wished to submit as part of the consultation process.

02/2021/08 – "Humber Talking you talk we will listen" survey: Clerk had previously submitted the Parish Council's replies to the survey and had received a request for further information on the items where concerns had been raised. Clerk asked the Councillors for further information regarding the issues:

Road Safety Issues: Councillors were concerned about tractors and some cars speeding through the village

Nuisance motorbikes: concern is mainly regarding bike users breaking into fields rather than through the village (often from the disused railway line).

Dog fouling: the main area where this seems to be a problem is along the disused railway line.

Clerk to submit these concerns.
