Minutes of the of Swine Parish Meeting held on 15th November 2022

11/2022/01 – Attendees: Cllrs Y Wilkinson, E McMullen, D Oliver, A Thompson, A Hunter and J Mackereth (arrived shortly after the meeting had commenced).

No members of the public were in attendance

11/2022/02 – Apologies: Cllr G Bloom

11/2022/03 – Approval of minutes:

Minutes of the meeting held on 16th August 2022 were read and approved as prepared.

11/2022/04 – Police Reports:

Crime reports received since the last meeting had been circulated to Councillors on email or hard copy prior to the meeting. Councillors offered no comments on these.

11/2022/05 – Clerk's Report:

Clerk reported that information had been passed to Pat Porter regarding the possible availability of funding to repair the Church clock from East Riding Stages Rally. Clerk also noted that the stones on the grass verge outside East/West View had been removed, but that there had been no response from East Riding of Yorkshire Council regarding the issues raised about the condition of the sign posts and the stile. Clerk also updated Councillors on the grass cutting schedule, as per the reply to the previous enquiry in 2021; grass is cut by East Riding of Yorkshire contractors on a 15 working day cycle from March to October.

11/2022/06 – Finance:

- (A) Bank balance was confirmed to be £956.10 as of 14th October.
- (B) The request for the expenditure of £224 in respect of the renewal of the Council's insurance policy with Zurich Insurance was considered and approved. Councillors were pleased that the premium had not increased given the current financial climate.
- (C) Consideration was given to the expenditure of £20 in respect of the wreath for Remembrance Sunday was considered and approved. Clerk informed the Councillors that Jacky Towers from the Royal British Legion in Hedon who deals with the wreaths is in poor health and is struggling to deal with the ongoing burden of this annual workload. Clerk will keep in touch and will assist Jacky if possible.

11/2022/07 – Humber Talking Survey:

Councillors considered the Survey and indicated that their major area of concern continued to be off-road motorcycles. They again considered that they had very little confidence that there would be urgent Police attendance if it was needed.

11/2022/08 – Consideration and completion of the Annual Snapshot of Rough Sleepers:

The time-frame for the “snapshot” was the evening previous to the meeting into the morning of the meeting. Councillors agreed that a “nil” return should be submitted.

11/2022/09 – Date of next meeting:

Next meeting was set for Tuesday 21st February 2023 at 7pm in St Mary’s Church Vestry.
